**Call for papers**

Within the initiatives organized by the *Consilium Conferentiarum Episcoporum Europae* (CCEE) for the celebration of the European Meeting of University Professors (Rome - June 21-24, 2007), the Italian Geographical Society ([www.societageografica.it](http://www.societageografica.it)) promotes and organizes the Conference “Migration and Citizenship: the role of the metropolis in the European Union process of enlargement” (Rome - June 22, 2007). All the geography professors of the European Universities are invited to participate.

**The Conference will be divided into two sessions:**

- 1) The transformations of the urban space and the processes of migration;
- 2) National, European and social citizenships.

The scholars interested in participating to the conference must send by e-mail to the Executive Secretary the title of his/her paper with a short summary (between 500 and 700 characters, spaces included) by **March 15, 2007**. The Scientific Committee will announce to the speakers the acceptance of his/her paper for the conference by **March 31, 2007**. The scholars whose papers will be accepted for the Conference will also have to send a larger abstract that will be distributed to the audience during the Conference (maximum 2,000 characters, spaces included) by **April 30, 2007**. The final text for publication (no more than 20,000 characters, spaces included) in English must be submitted by **September 30, 2007**. The Committee will promptly send the editorial rules for the publication to the speakers admitted to the Conference.

The Italian Geographical Society, besides hosting the Conference, will publish the proceedings of the Conference, possibly by the year 2007.

A second letter, with attached the conference subscription form and more detailed information about hotels with special offers for the participants to the conference, will soon be distributed.

To participate in the Conference ([www.university2000.org](http://www.university2000.org)) the Rome Diocese will ask for a solidarity contribution of 25 euros.
